[ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION LAB](#)

The Lab covers approximately 2 miles of forested walking trails winding through 80 acres of diverse landscape. Completed in 1994 through the combined efforts of natural resources professionals, educators, and youth groups, the Lab offers a wide variety of educational opportunities. If you are interested in learning more about the natural world we live in and enjoying the sights and sounds of the forest, this is for you. Also included are an Observation Platform, Interpretive Trails, Main Trail Loop and the Manistique Papers Inc. Boardwalk. Call the Chamber of Commerce for more information or directions. SENEY NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

COLWELL LAKE TRAIL

The Colwell Lake trail is located at Colwell Lake in the Hiawatha National Forest approximately twenty-six miles north of Manistique on M-94. The surface is blacktop and Handicap accessible. Contact the Hiawatha National Forest at 906-341-5666.



FAYETTE STATE PARK

Once a bustling industrial community that manufactured charcoal pig iron between 1867 and 1891, Fayette offers visitors a well-preserved museum village and hiking trails in the verdant state park. Park is open from mid May to mid October. (906) 644-2603



INDIAN LAKE PATHWAY

A series of three loops totaling approximately four-and-one-half miles, the Indian Lake Pathway is located on County Road 149 in Manistique.
