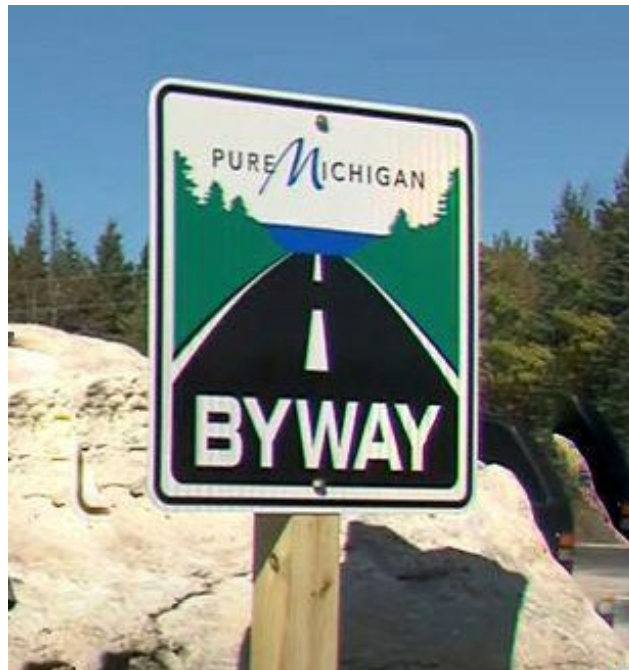


## *All signs point to*

## ORV/ATV Trails

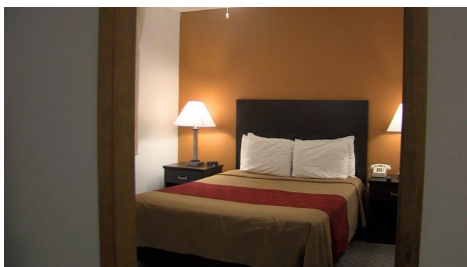

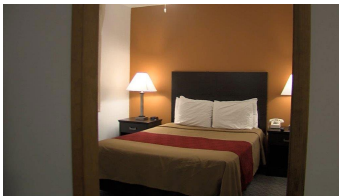
