

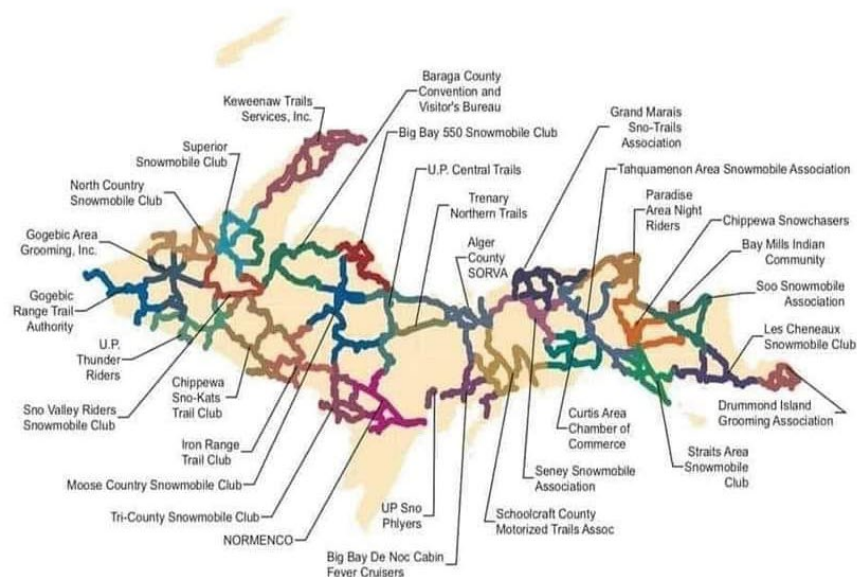


Six more weeks of Winter?
