

More Than 50 Years of fun:

The Haywire Grade Trail

Michigan's first rail trail turns 55 years old in 2025. It is a year-round multi-use trail that crosses the Upper Peninsula north to south from Shingleton to Manistique.

History

The trail's historical significance dates to the late 1800s. The Manistique and Northwestern Railroad began operation in 1898 and reorganized as the Manistique and Lake Superior in 1909. The railroad served the logging industry and fostered settlement in the region. Many of the trees harvested from the area were sent to Illinois to help rebuild after the Great Chicago Fire.

Interpretation

There is a series of 11 historical interpretive kiosks installed along the trail. The kiosks were fabricated with steel from Upper Peninsula railroad tracks and cedar logs grown in the region. Each kiosk also contains metal art depicting a train engine and Manistique and Lake Superior railroad cars.

ATV fun!

Challenging trails for the off-road enthusiast can be found throughout the Manistique area, including the Haywire Grade Trail. Riding opportunities abound along abandoned railroad grades for a near straight jaunt. Hundreds of miles of scenic and historic trails are ready for today's rider.



Fat Tire bike riding & more

The trail surface is a mix of sand, gravel and coarse limestone, designed for snowmobiles and ATVs, but suitable for fat-tire biking. You'll find a small grocery store in the tiny hamlet of Steuben, the last vestige of the many logging camps or towns that vanished after the railroad was abandoned.

Multi-use



In 1970 the Haywire Grade Trail was reclassified as a year-round, multi use trail – the first in the Upper Peninsula. The Haywire Grade is most commonly used for biking, ATVirg and snowmobiling, although it is also open to hiking and horseback riding.



Trailheads

Trail Length: 32 miles between Manistique and Shingleton

MANISTIQUE TRAILHEAD

Intake Park Road - Manistique, Michigan (across from Manistique Pumping Station)

JACK PINE TRAILHEAD

Jack Pine Lodge on M-94 (about half way between Manistique and Shingleton).

NORTHERN TRAILHEAD

A sign marks the northern trailhead on the east side of M-94 just south of Shingleton. There is no parking, but spaces are available east of the Tanglewood Restaurant and Antique Shop on M-28 in Shingleton less than a quarter mile north of the trail.

There is a reason to visit Manistique all four seasons. Within a day's drive there are state parks, a national forest, fishing, hiking, history and nature. Make it your resolve to explore more in 2025. Come stay play, shop and dine with us.
