



Seul Choix Lighthouse, built in 1892, once guided French and Native American fur traders on the rough waters of Lake Michigan. Today fishermen and sailors still rely on its fully operational beacon for safe passage. Tours and Museum open Memorial Day through Mid-September.

The *Bishop Baraga Shrine* near Indian Lake includes a chapel, Indian dwellings, and build-ings open to the public.



Abundant wildlife populates this tranquil setting and can be viewed by auto, bicycle, canoe or on foot. From December through mid-March, you can snowshoe or ski cross country on beautifully groomed trails.
